#### **HOW TO DETECT GAS LEAKS**

SMELL Rotten eggs odor (added for detection)

E

LISTEN
Hissing sound
near cylinder/hose



LOOK
Bubbles in soapy water
at connections

#### **ALWAYS DO**

- ✓ Store cylinders upright in ventilated areas
- ✓ Turn off gas when not in use
- ✓ Keep 1 meter away from heat sources
- ✓ Check for leaks monthly with soapy water
- ✓ Replace hoses every 2 years
- Use certified regulators and equipment
- ✓ Keep fire extinguisher accessible
- Ensure good kitchen ventilation

#### × NEVER DO

- ✓ Use matches/lighters to detect leaks
- Store cylinders near flames or heat
- ✗ Swap gas with valve open

- Store in basements or enclosed spaces
- ★ 修Ignore gas smell report immediately
- ✗ Drop, throw, or roll cylinders
- ★ Use damaged or rusty cylinders
- ✗ Modify or repair cylinders yourself

### **505 IF YOU SMELL GAS**

- 1. **DON'T PANIC** No flames, no switches
- 2. **TURN OFF** cylinder valve immediately
- 3. **VENTILATE** Open all doors and windows
- 4. **EVACUATE** Leave the area if smell persists
- 5. **CALL US** 24/7 emergency support below
